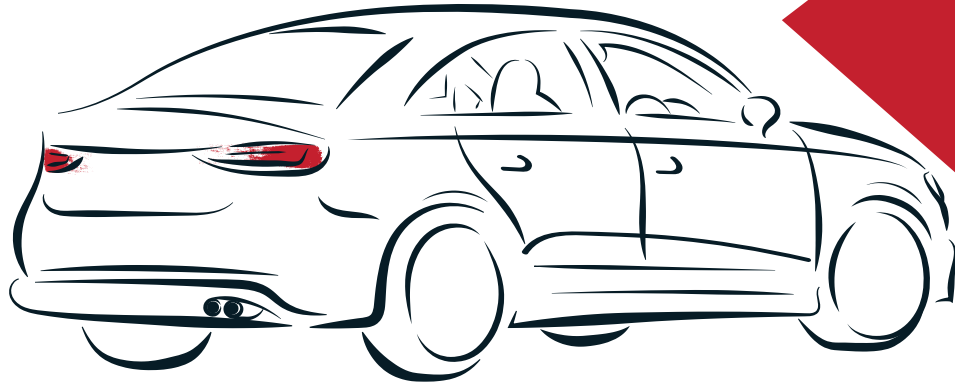
FLAT STALLS

(\$6 per hour)



- Inform tool crib attendant of work you are going to perform. Tools will be issued.
- Jack stands are to be used at all times when the vehicle's wheels are off the ground.
- Any fluid spills need to be wiped up immediately. Follow guidelines for disposal by shop personnel.
- Impact guns, ratchets & impact sockets are available for use from the tool crib. Do not use sockets from tool boxes with impact guns or ratchets as they can explode and cause injury.
- Gray trash cans are for trash ONLY. Dispose metal parts in the metal bin behind the shop.
- No open flame torches allowed in the shop.
- Each flat and brake stall (red lifts) has a tool box available.
- Exhaust hoses are to be used anytime vehicle is running, unless backing out of stall.

All work stops 30 minutes before closing time to clean up and turn in equipment. No fee for vehicles left inside overnight. Fee resumes the next time the shop is open for business, whether the patron is there or not. Payments can be made by Cash, Check, Visa or Master Card.

AUTO RESALE LOT

\$7.50 for 7 days/Renewable

- Located on the South side of the base gas station on Arnold St.
 - Permits are issued at the cashier window in the Auto Hobby Shop.
 - Park vehicle in area designated by the Auto Hobby Staff. Instruction will be provided at time of permit being issued.
 - Before the three forms can be presented, proof of ownership, document (title, registration, or tag agency form) are required.
 - Name of ownership document must match the name of the person selling the vehicle.
- * Only legal owner can place the vehicle on the resale lot. Credit card number must be left at the time of vehicle registration. The following is a disclaimer and credit card information is required in order to register a vehicle.

1. Only active duty military, retired military, reserve components, civilian personnel or other authorized personnel assigned to Tinker AFB vehicle owners may utilize the Auto Resale Mart.
2. All user fees are administrative fees and are not assessed to provide protection of me vehicle. Although the lot will be routinely patrolled by Security Forces, the Air Force does not assume unconditional responsibility for my vehicle.
3. Auto Mart spaces are issued on a weekly basis and must be renewed as required. A rental fee of \$7.50 for 7 days is due on each vehicle displayed on the lot at the time of registration.
 4. A late fee of \$2 per day will be assessed if payment is not made the first business day following expiration. Your credit card will be charged the late fee and any charges in arrears, to include a \$25 lost permit fee if not returned when fees are paid.
5. Sellers with expired permits will have their credit card charged for each day until permits are returned and if over 14 days, the vehicle may be disposed of by Security Forces.
6. It is my responsibility to keep my vehicle secured or locked and that the Air Force or Air Force personnel will not be responsible for any damages to my vehicle or the contents thereof as the result of vandalism or other damage.
7. It is the policy of the 72d ABW Commander that all persons utilizing the lots have all required minimum liability insurance coverage to provide financial protection in the event of damage or loss to my property.
8. I understand that my vehicle may only be parked with the permit assigned to me and no vehicle other than the one described above as registered may be placed in this space.

4a. Arts and Crafts Center will inspect the Auto Mart Daily. Vehicles without valid permits will be cited/and or wheel locked. Seller with expired permits will be assessed \$2 per day until permit is returned. Lost permits will be assessed \$25. In addition, all customers will leave a valid credit card number with expiration date and authorization to charge any payments in arrears.

4b. Arts and Crafts Center personnel will attempt to contact sellers with expired permits. Unless all payments in arrears are paid within 5 days, seller's credit card will be charged for each day permit is not returned and if the vehicle remains on the lot over 14 days, it may be disposed of by the 72d Security Forces. Towing is at owner's expense.

BRAKE RACKS

Stalls 5 & 8 (\$10 per hour)

No low profile or modified vehicles permitted.

- Before driving on rack, get a shop personnel to assist you in driving on the ramp.
- Position jacks properly before operating. There are two jacks, one for front and one for back.
- When work is complete, lower vehicle and place both jacks to the front of the rack.
- Get a shop personnel to assist you backing the vehicle off the rack. If brake rack work was done, remember to pump the brake pedal several times before placing vehicle in gear.
- Clean area and tools, turn tools in at the crib, and pay invoice.
